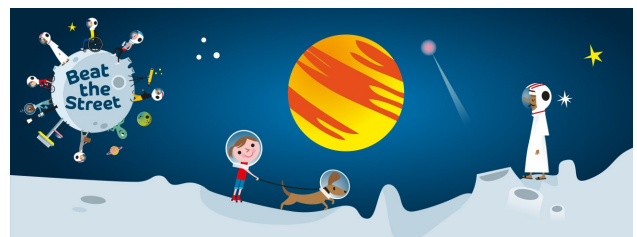
Please donate tins or packets of...
