Admission Criteria – Nursery places are allocated in the following priority:

1. 'Child Looked After' A CLA is:
 - (a) In the care of a local authority or
 - (b) Being provided with accommodation by a local authority in the exercise of their social services function defined by Section 22 (1) of the Children Act 1989.
2. Any child who has a sibling attending Bridlewood Primary School or nursery at the same time as he or she is due to be admitted, committing to 15 or 30 hours provision.
3. Children living closest to the school within the school's catchment area committing to 15 or 30 hours provision.
4. Children not living in the school's catchment area, committing to the full 15 or 30 hours provision.
5. Children not wanting to commit to the full 15 or 30 hours provision.
