

Child Friendly Anti Bullying Policy

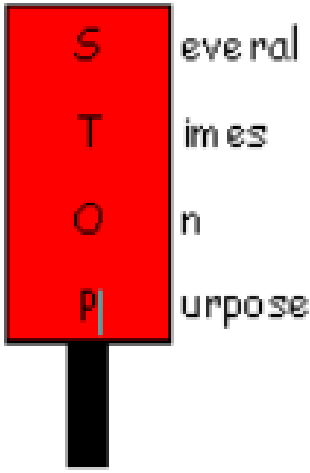


What is bullying?

A bully is someone who hurts someone else by using behaviour which is meant to hurt, frighten or hurt another person. This behaviour is repeated frequently.

BULLYING IS NOT

A one off fight, an argument with a friend, or a spur of the moment spiteful comment.



DO

Tell a teacher, adult or friend.
Tell the bully to stop.
Use the worry box.

DON'T

Copy the behaviour of the bully.
Do it back to them.
Join in with the bullying behaviour.
