Introduction to Year 2 end of year assessments

All children at the end of Year 2 must be formally assessed.

This takes the form of teacher assessments and tests that inform these assessments.

This will enable us to create a rounded judgement of your child's abilities and identify if they are working at the expected standard for year 2.

The Tests

- KS1 Reading Test
- KS1 English grammar, punctuation and spelling test - optional
- KS1 Mathematics - Arithmetic and Reasoning

Other Assessments

- Assessed writing
- Mental mathematics tests
- Handwriting
- Spelling

Preparation

- Reading comprehensions
- Maths problems in the style of the written questions that they will see in the tests
- SPaG quizzes
- Learning spelling patterns and rules
- Times tables quizzes
