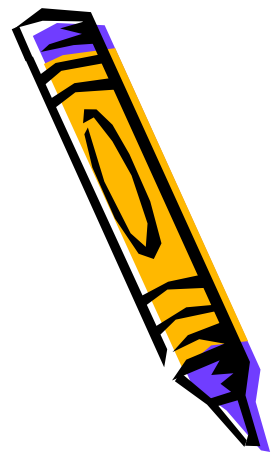


The Foundation Stage



Number

- ◆ Count reliably up to 20 objects
- ◆ Order numbers correctly to 20
- ◆ Be able to say one more or one less than a given number
- ◆ Add and subtract single digit numbers using objects
- ◆ Begin to double, halve and share

Addition

Add single digit numbers using objects

Subtraction

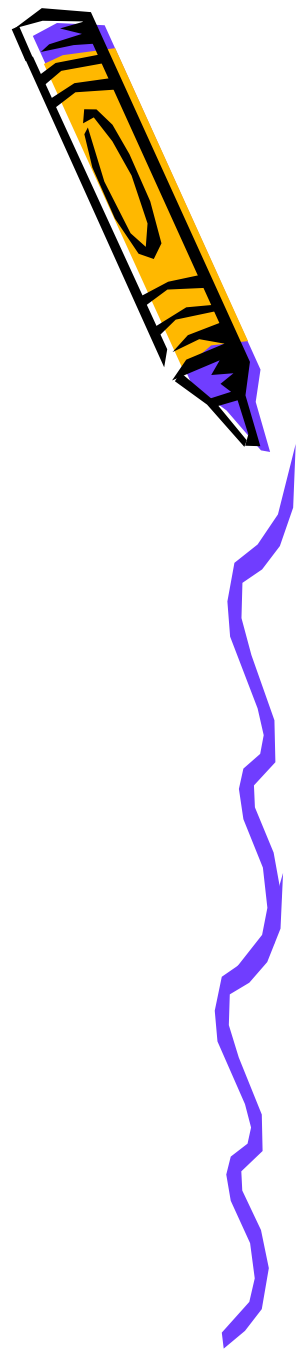
Subtract single digit numbers using objects

Multiplication

Counting in 2s, then 5s and 10s

Division

Practically halving and sharing



Helping at Home

- Make it enjoyable, real and relate it to your child's interests.
- 'I have 5 dinosaurs and you have 3 dinosaurs, how many do we have altogether?'
- 'Dad has 10 sweets, if Mum eats 3 how many will be left?'
- Jump to stairs 2 at a time and count as you go. Using real money to count in 2s, 5s and 10s is also useful.
- Can you give half of your orange to your brother? How many pieces will he have? How many will you have?
- Can you share your sweets with your sister so you both have the same?
