In Term Four, our topic across the school is book based. We will be purchasing books as a school to support the topic but are aware that some of the children may choose to purchase their own copy of the book, to keep at home.

If you would like to provide your child with a copy of the book to support them in this topic, the list of books being covered is below:

Cherry – Owl Babies by Martin Waddell
Pine – Cinderella Grimm's Fairy Tales
Ash – The BFG by Roald Dahl
Elm – Carrie's War by Nina Bawden
Birch – Clockwork by Philip Pullman
Rowan – Holes by Louis Sachar
Maple – Holes by Louis Sachar
Oak – Goodnight Mr Tom by Michelle Magorian
Yew - Goodnight Mr Tom by Michelle Magorian

Thursday 1 March is **World Book Day** and we would invite children to **dress up** as a book character to come to school. They may also wish to bring a copy of their favourite story to share on that day.

As part of our topic we will be visiting the **Oxford Storytelling Museum** for workshops, which are suitable for Year 1 to Year 6, and book based activities. Classes will visit the museum on the following days:

Tuesday 20 February – Pine and Ash Class
Wednesday 21 February – Yew and Oak Class
Thursday 22 February – Maple and Rowan Class
Friday 23 February – Birch and Elm Class

The school will be paying for the museum but we do ask for contributions towards the cost of coach travel of £6.00 per pupil. Unfortunately, all the trips may be cancelled if we do not receive enough contributions to cover the cost of travel by Thursday 1st February.

Children will need to bring in a packed lunch on the day of their visit. If you would like the school to provide a packed lunch, it can be ordered in the usual way through parentpay, this includes children who are entitled to free school meals.
